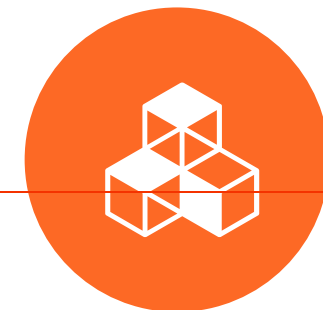
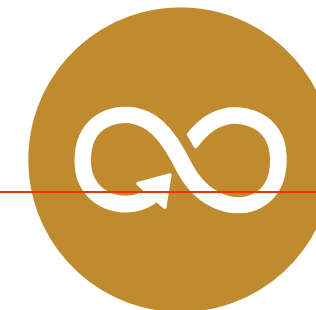
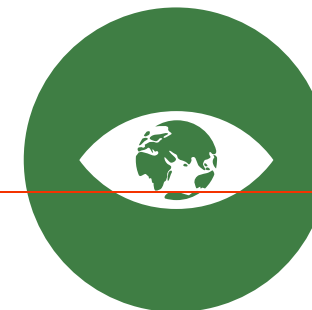
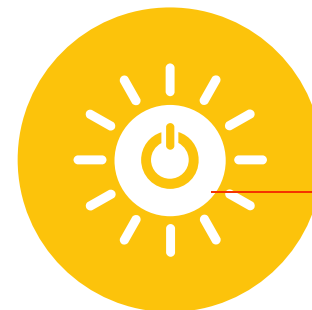
Effluent Water Treatment Plant (ETP)

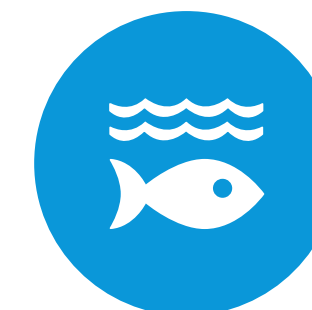
Harnessing Solar Energy
